Dear Governor DeSantis,

I have been harassed, threatened, and turned away from store after store, banks, optometrists, and salons who will not serve me (which is 100% illegal as it violates discrimination statutes on State and Federal levels). The stress has become unbearable and there is no justification for being treated this way.

Here in Broward County, just about every store treats me with hostility when I come in without a mask.

Never, at any time, since all of this started, was the inalienable rights under the U.S. and Florida Constitutions ever suspended. That is the definition of *inalienable rights*.

Even with your State of Emergency, which never met a true legal definition to be declared, **any and all** living flesh and blood human beings have the right, regardless of medical and religious conditions and practices, to go into any place of public accommodation without being discriminated against.

I was so happy when you lifted these draconian illegal mandates. However, Broward County is full of signs that say, "WEAR A MASK, STAND SIX FEET APART". And businesses that have no right to force me to wear a mask are treating me with utter disrespect. Enough is enough.

You have been remiss on this issue, allowing your citizens to be harassed and discriminated against.

We must eliminate this tyranny once and for all.

- You must order that all signage requiring masks and all the other "guidance" that was never legitimate law, be removed at once. Both, from public places, and from business and government services windows and doors.
- You must order the local governments to remove **all** signage.
- You must create an executive order or legal notice that informs all businesses and government agencies that if they continue to discriminate against individuals in the public, that the police departments will enforce those discrimination laws... both Federal and Florida Statutes.

- Further, you must either lift the state of emergency, or rebut, with affidavit, the absolute proof that the state of emergency, based upon epidemic, was legitimate at the time of the first executive order regarding the state of emergency. Further, you must either lift the state of emergency, or rebut, with affidavit, the absolute proof that an epidemic, by legal definition has existed since the time of the original declaration.
- Further, for the sake of Florida and the nation at large, you must clarify publicly, the true purpose of executive orders, and make clear, the fact that executive orders are **not law**, and are not to be treated as such, as it defies the very foundation of our constitutional republic.

Essentially, what you must do is **UPHOLD THE CONSTITUTION FOR WHICH YOU TOOK AN OATH TO UPHOLD.**

I look forward to hearing the resolution you will put forth, correcting the actions of government agencies and businesses against the people of Florida, dropping the unlawful state of emergency, and widely publicizing a return to complete normalcy with discrimination enforcement in full force.

I expect, as I always have, that Police Officers will arrest any store manager who denies me services based on my **choice to not** wear a mask.

I expect, as should always be the case, that if a store manager or employee stands in front of me to block my entrance into a store, that Police Officers will arrest said person for false imprisonment (look up the definition if need be).

I expect, that if a store manager or employee lays a hand on me at all, that Police Officers will arrest that person on assault charges (look up the definition if need be).

I expect, that if a store manager or employee yells at me, or verbally demeans me, that that person will be arrested on assault charges.

If I do not get this satisfaction... or, if my personal health continues to deteriorate because of this undue stress... I will most certainly sue and bring charges against any government official that is responsible for allowing these injustices and unenforced discrimination statues to continue.
